#### LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 2022, by and between Terre Haute Regional Airport Authority, hereinafter referred to as "Lessor," and Indiana Paging Network, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "Lessee."

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Lessor now owns and operates an airport designated as Terre Haute Regional Airport in Vigo County, State of Indiana; and

WHEREAS, Lessee is engaged in the business of Paging Telecommunications and desires to conduct such an operation at Lessor's facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual undertakings, agreements and covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

#### **ARTICLE 1 - PREMISES**

Lessor does hereby demise and let unto Lessee, and Lessee hereby rents and takes from Lessor, the exclusive use of approximately 132 square feet of space in the Airport Administration Building as identified and located on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

#### ARTICLE 2 - USE OF PREMISES

Lessee shall use the leased premises in connection with or incidental to its Paging Telecommunications Services and for no other purpose.

#### ARTICLE 3 - RIGHT TO INSPECT PREMISES

Lessor shall have the right to enter upon and inspect the premises occupied by Lessee from time to time during the term hereof and, upon reasonable notice to Lessee except in such case as when an emergency develops wherein no notice is required, to make any repairs deemed necessary by the Lessor without abatement of rent provided, however, that Lessor shall not, during the course of any such inspection, unreasonably interfere with the Lessee.

#### **ARTICLE 4 - RIGHT OF ACCESS**

Lessor shall grant the unrestricted access and ingress to, and egress from the leased premises, for Lessee, its employees, guests, patrons, invitees, suppliers and furnisher service.

#### **ARTICLE 5 - TERM OF AGREEMENT**

The term of this Agreement shall be for a period of five (5) years, commencing on the 1st day of July, 2022 and terminating on the 30th day of June, 2027.

#### **ARTICLE 6 - RENT**

Lessee agrees to pay Lessor an annual rental in the amount of Three Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$3,300.00) for the term of the lease agreement, payable in twelve (12) equal monthly installments of Two Hundred Eighteen Dollars and seventy-five cents (\$275) each, which said installment shall be paid in advance, commencing July 1, 2022, and on the 1st day of each month thereafter.

In the event the beginning or termination date of this lease shall fall on any date other than the

1st day of the calendar month, then there shall be a prorate adjustment in that monthly rental according to the number of days the premises were actually under lease to the Lessee during that particular month.

#### ARTICLE 7 - TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

Either party may terminate this agreement by sixty (60) days written notice to the other party.

#### **ARTICLE 8 - MAINTENANCE**

Lessee shall at all time:

- 1. At Lessee's own expense, keep and maintain the leased premises in a clean and orderly condition.
- At Lessee's own expense, provide a complete and proper arrangement for the adequate sanitary handling and disposal, away from the airport premises, of all trash, garbage and other refuse caused as a result of its operation at the airport or accumulated at the leased premises.
  - At Lessee's own expense, provide and maintain its own air conditioning unit.

#### ARTICLE 9 - LESSOR'S OBLIGATIONS

Lessor agrees to provide all heating, and normal amounts of electricity to said premises at no additional cost to Lessee.

#### ARTICLE 10 - EQUIPMENT INTERFERENCE

Upon reasonable notice to Lessee, Lessor reserves the right to take any action it deems necessary to protect the Airport's and the Federal Aviation Administration's radio and electronic equipment from any and all interference caused by Lessee's equipment.

#### ARTICLE 11 - HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

Lessee shall hold Lessor harmless from any claims, demands or causes of action of any nature whatsoever arising out of the conduct of Lessee, its officers, agents, and/or employees, in the operation of Lessee's facility.

#### **ARTICLE 12 - ASSIGNMENTS AND SUBLEASE**

Lessee shall not assign this lease or sublet the leased premises.

#### **ARTICLE 13 - DEFAULT BY LESSEE**

In the event Lessee shall fail to correct any default in its compliance with the terms of this Lease, after receiving written notice thereof, Lessor shall be entitled to recover from Lessee any costs incurred by Lessor in securing Lessee's compliance, including but not limited to reasonable attorney fees.

#### ARTICLE 14 - PUBLIC AIRPORT FACILITY

The granting of this lease and its acceptance by Lessee is conditioned upon the right of said Lessee and the general public to use the public airport facilities maintained at Terre Haute International Airport in common with other authorized to do so provided, however, that Lessee shall observe and comply with any and all requirements of all federal, state and local statutes, ordinances, regulations and standards applicable to the use of the area leased by Lessee including, but not limited to, the rules and regulations promulgated from time to time by Lessor or its authorized agents.

#### ARTICLE 15 - INDEMNITY AND LESSEE'S INSURANCE

Lessee covenants and agrees that it shall indemnify and save forever harmless the Lessor, its officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims, demands, and causes of action of any kind and nature whatsoever, including attorney fees, which may hereafter be made against the Lessor on account of any personal injuries, including wrongful death, or property damage resulting from the Lessee's use of the airport premises, except claims that arise from acts of negligence on the part of the Lessor, its officers, agents, and employees. For this purpose, Lessee shall procure and maintain in effect for the entire term of this Agreement and at its sole expense maintain liability insurance against claims for bodily injury, death or property damage, including products liability insurance, covering all of Lessee's activities at the airport for a combined single limit of One million dollars (\$1,000,000.00).

Lessee shall furnish Lessor with a Certificate of Insurance setting forth the coverage set forth above and listing Lessor, its officers, agents, and employees as additional insured under the policy or policies and provide further certification from the company or companies that said policy or policies cannot be canceled or materially modified except upon providing thirty (30) days advance written notice to Lessor. Lessee shall furnish the Lessor with an endorsement waiving their rights of subrogation against the Lessor.

Lessee shall have the responsibility with its landlord during the entire term of this Agreement to maintain in effect, or to cause same to be kept in effect, adequate insurance for fire and extended coverage of the facilities occupied by Lessee and any personal property therein.

In the event of damage to or destruction of the building, or any part thereof by fire or any casualty so as to be rendered untenable by the Lessee, and which as a result it is reasonably assumed that it will take more than ninety (90) days to restore the building to the condition it was in immediately prior to the occurrence of the casualty, and if the lease hereunder shall not have been terminated pursuant to any provision of this section, then, the rent payable by Lessee shall abate in direct ratio to that portion of the premises rendered untenable and the time of tenancy lost.
